Guests can now stay in the gardens at the iconic Saint James Paris, the city's only chateau hotel.

PARIS, FRANCE (May 2, 2024) – Guests at the [Saint James Paris](#) hotel can now experience its gardens from a unique perspective by staying in one of two private **Pavilion Rooms** in the chateau's former gatehouses, each with a terrace and private spa.

The gardens themselves are the signature of Saint James Paris. As the only chateau hotel in Paris surrounded by its own gardens, much of the hotel's identity is derived from their beauty. The interior design and culinary program were both inspired by the gardens and the hotel's unique setting in the center of the city.

Each of the new Pavilion Rooms underwent a full renovation inside and out, reimagined by interior designer Laura Gonzalez, who designed the hotel and its adjacent villa.

"Staying in the Pavilions is like experiencing in your own private cottage in central Paris," says General Manager Laure Pertusier. "We're so pleased to be able to offer this unique experience to guests to enjoy these special gardens in privacy yet have access to our five-star services of the hotel just steps away."

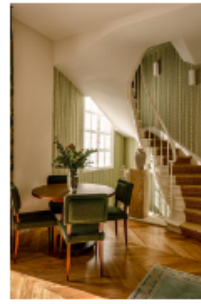
Guests of the Pavilions have a dedicated garden path and terrace to enter their private residence. Each Pavilion is 860 square feet across three floors. The living room is on the ground floor and offers a pull-out sofa bed for one adult or two children. Upstairs is the

master bedroom and en-suite shower room. Downstairs is a private spa consisting of a large jet bathtub, a dry sauna, and an exercise bike. Guerlain Treatments can be ordered in each Pavilion's private spa in case guests prefer not to visit the Guerlain spa inside the hotel.

Named Elise and Félicie, the Pavilions pay tribute to Elise and Félicie Dosne, wife and sister-in-law of former French President Adolphe Thiers, in the memory of whom they erected the building of the Saint James Paris (which was first a Foundation for the best students in France from 1892 to 1985).

A Garden-Inspired Stay

The gardens at the doorstep of the Pavilions are a natural protected area within the city of Paris and the hotel takes great steps to preserve their beauty and that of the environment. As part of the hotel's 2022 full renovation, landscape designer Xavier de Chirac planned the Saint James gardens to be magnificent in every season with color and scents to experience year round.

The hotel's garden-inspired restaurant, **Bellefeuille**, which last month retained its Michelin star under new chef Grégory Garimbay, also received a Green Star for sustainability by the Michelin Guide, a distinction highlighting its commitment to a more responsible and environmentally-friendly cuisine. This distinction honors the efforts of the teams which includes focusing on fresh and eco-responsible ingredients for its dishes and evening tasting menus, and serving vegetables grown in the hotel's organic garden south of Paris and brought to the Saint James by electric van.

Owned by Olivier Bertrand and his family, Saint James Paris and its sister hotels, **Relais Christine** in the Latin Quarter, and the soon-to-open **Hotel Balzac**, off the Champs-Élysées, are members of Relais & Châteaux. The family's other properties include the new, néo-art-nouveau-inspired **Château des Fleurs** and the **Hotel Norman**, which was inspired by modernist graphic designer Norman Ives, both in the 8th Arr. near the top of the Champs-Élysées.
