What destinations do you cover?	All of Morocco — classic itineraries and off-the-beaten-path experiences with consistent quality and reliable logistics countrywide.

Currency & CC fees?	EUR or USD — flexible. USD accepted. 3% CC processing fee.
How do you quote?	Net rates standard — advisors apply their own markup.
Proposal turnaround?	Within 24 hours for an initial draft (may vary slightly in peak season).
What software do you use?	Proposals delivered as designed PDF or PowerPoint — clean, visual, easy to share with clients.
Payment schedule?	30% deposit at confirmation; balance due prior to arrival or per supplier conditions.
Cancellation policy?	Based on specific services and suppliers involved. Full terms communicated transparently at confirmation.
How is commission paid?	Bank transfer within 3 business days after guest departure.
In-destination support?	Full support throughout — dedicated local contacts provided before arrival, operations team available for logistics, last-minute changes, and emergencies.
